A New Website. At least this is a new website to me and I would like to share it with all of you. The website is: www.craftconn.com and they sell everything a quilter might want, as well as lots of other craft items such as scrapbooking goods and beads.

I think that the amount of fabric you can buy is astonishing. I was looking for a particular fabric that I couldn't find anywhere. Lo and behold, there it was.

When you go onto this website and push the fabric button, a page comes up allowing you to see what they have. Fabrics can be found by manufacturer, color or subject. There about 60 different categories.

Select one category, for instance, Moda marbles. They carry every color, there are five pages to look at, there are 210 Moda marble fabrics.

And, fellow quilters, you can buy a fat quarter, a yard, a half yard or three quarters of a yard. If you wish to buy the bolt, you get 25% off the retail price.

But the best part! If you want to see how your fabrics go together you pick what you like, put them into your shopping cart (they can be deleted later) and select Design-a Block. This will take you to an area that will include a sample of each of the fabrics you have in your shopping cart. Here you can put them together to see how they look, do they clash or are they exactly what you are looking for? From that point you can place an order, empty your cart or whatever.

I had some questions regarding what I wanted and called the store for help. They were delightful and happy to help in any way they could. I would recommend the site to all, at least take a look.
